



Viquid glass enamels

Viquid glass enamels are an easy to use range of colours that you can use to paint on glass – allowing you to embellish your design and add fine details that would be difficult to achieve with glass alone.

Why use Viquid glass enamels?

- Fuse with a shiny, glassy finish
- Don't crack when you use heavily
- More than 20 colours available
- Water soluble
- Can be mixed together to create new colours
- Can be fired at the same time as fusing (needs to reach 750°C to 825°C)



The liquid is dispensed through a fine nozzle but you may prefer to squirt it onto a palette and apply it with a brush



By applying a 'dry line' (an outline with a small amount of viquid on your brush) you can then add more to your brush and flood the area within the lines – paint applied will not overrun the dry line therefore giving you a crisp outline



Once applied, the viquid dries within minutes and becomes powdery which allows you to trap the viquid between two layers of glass without disturbing it, or to paint other colours on top without disturbing your initial design



As well as being able to mix the colours, by mixing the viquid with a little water you can create a lighter shade
